Basic Truth: God loves me.

Love Clap

What You Do: Sit with or hold your baby or toddler. Clap your hands and help them to clap their hands to the rhythm of the words. Continue as long as there is interest.

What You Say: "Can you clap your hands? Let's clap while I say a fun rhyme. Ready? One, two, God loves you! Now you do it. One, two, God loves you! Yay!"

Parachute Fun

What You Need: Parachute (or large towel/sheet) and foam/paper hearts

What You Do: Gather toddler and friends around the parachute. Make the parachute go up and shout, "God loves." As you bring it down, shout, "You." Add foam hearts for popping fun. Continue as long as there is interest.

What You Say: "I have a fun game for us to play. Let's all gather around this parachute. Can you make it go up and down? When we go up, we're going to say, 'God loves' and as we bring it down, we'll say 'You.' Great job! Let's add these fun hearts and see if we can make them pop. Wow! Now, make it shake really hard. Let's see all that love shaking. God loves you so very much!"
