



## BREAKING THE ICE

---

## MAIN CONTENT

---

This week Pastor Kevin was back with us and talking about the idea of Anything's Possible. He started the message with a picture of the new Cross Point Church sign at our Nashville location. The sign says "Anything's Possible". The sign changed because we believe that with Jesus Anything is Possible and we want others to have hope in knowing that.

1. When you hear the saying "Anything's Possible" what do you think?

When we believe that God is our protector and He is our provider, we can have faith that with Him, anything is possible. We want the Anything's Possible sign to be a reminder and a note of hope for those who need to have faith in something.

2. Where or what do you put your faith in when it comes to believing that something good will happen for you?

God wants to restore faith in our lives. He wants our faith to be bolstered to know that truly anything is possible if we just trust and believe in Him. Faith is trusting, obeying and seeking God. It's easy to trust God with our eternity but we tend to trust in ourselves when it comes to other things.

3. What is one thing you have not fully trusted God with? Why?

There are three pillars of conviction that help us believe Anything's Possible.

The first pillar is, **there's nobody God can't reach**. We read in Mark 4:35 - Mark 5: 1-20 about the demon possessed man whom Jesus saved. No one wanted anything to do with this man. He was an outcast and

considered dangerous to society. Yet Jesus came into the scene and rescued him.

4. Who in your life is far from God, so far you would think there's no way God can reach them? What will it take for you to trust God with that person?

5. Describe a time where you saw God reach someone you never thought would turn to Him.

Jesus will never force Himself on us. He is always available to us, we just have to engage Him. It takes having faith and trusting Him with our lives to see the changes we are hoping for.

The second pillar of conviction is, **there's nobody God can't use**. God used the story of the demon possessed man to reach crowds of people. Everyone was shocked that the half crazed man appeared to be normal after being around Jesus. God used his story to reach hundreds and potentially thousands of people (Matthew 15:29-31). This man who seemed too far gone and irredeemable walked away from Jesus sharing the good news of what He did for him.

6. Name someone God placed in your life to help you learn more about Him.

The last pillar of conviction is, **there's no place God can't revive**. The story of the demon possessed man was based in a town you would want to visit. It seemed to be a society that was described as dark as it practiced other religions.

Yet once the demon possessed man was healed, the people in the society became curious about Jesus. After years of this man being tormented and trying everything to heal him; he found his healing and redemption in Jesus. His healing revived the town, it caused them to look past their false religions and to ask questions about Jesus.

7. Where have you seen revival in your life?

When we truly believe that there's nobody God can't reach, nobody God can't use and no place God can't revive; we can grasp through Him that anything is possible.

8. What is the anything's possible dream you have in your life right now?

God we are so thankful that with you anything is truly possible. There is nothing you can't do. The people in our lives that are far from you, we give them to you. We no longer want to believe the lies that you can't use us. In the places that look hopeless God, we believe you can revive them. Will you remind us of these things and help us draw near to you and trust you with our lives, our friends and loved ones lives

and the things and places in our lives that need revived. In Jesus' name. Amen.
