


GROUPS March 2022 Week 4



SERVICE

Colossians 3:23-24 "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ."

Acts 20:35 "In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

The most important detail to remember as we walk through sacred rhythms is that a rhythm isn't a one-and-done check-the-box experience. The word Rhythm implies an ongoing routine. This is so important to remember while we look at service. Jesus built discipleship relationships with those he served. Serving increases our capacity to see people how God sees them, which allows us to care for them in a way that is more honoring than if we were just going through the motions.

- 3. What are needs in your community that could be met through people regularly serving in those areas?
