FAITH

Matthew 13:55-58 — ⁵⁵ “Isn’t this the carpenter’s son? Isn’t his mother’s name Mary, and aren’t his brothers James, Joseph, Simon and Judas? ⁵⁶ Aren’t all his sisters with us? Where then did this man get all these things?” ⁵⁷ And they took offense at him. But Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own town and in his own home.” ⁵⁸ And he did not do many miracles there because of their lack of faith.

In this scripture, we see that a lack of faith kept Jesus from doing many of the miracles that He had a heart to do in his hometown. There are things in our lives that God is longing to do, that if we had a little faith, we would see accomplished. And we don’t have to muster it up, Jesus says that faith the size of a mustard seed can move mountains. If anything is possible for God, then faith isn’t an optional add-on at the dealership of life; faith is the pre-requisite for everything that God wants to do in and through our lives.
