Primary Responsibilities

- Be the primary connector of the Nashville Campus: know and pastor volunteers and attendees in all ministry areas and help people find their next step at Cross Point
- Oversee the Nashville Community Pastor and provide support in the areas of Groups and College Ministry.
- Oversee the Local Good Director and provide ongoing support in local partnerships, benevolence and ongoing local good opportunities
- Work with campus staff to "give ministry back" by equipping strong volunteers to both lead and execute ministry.
- Collaborate with fellow staff members to steward our resources well.
- Serve as part of the global Cross Point team on any "all hands on deck" events
- Along with the Nashville Community Pastor, assist with pastoral care needs, helping counsel when needed and connecting people in the congregation with next steps for external counseling and resources.
