



## **Audio, Visual & Lighting Assistant (*Full-Time*)**

### **Position Summary**

The AVL Technician (Audio, Video, and Lighting) is an integral position within Cross Point that offers a unique opportunity to contribute to the worship experience through the operation and maintenance of audio, video, and lighting equipment. The ideal candidate for this role has a foundational knowledge of AVL (Audio, Video, and Lighting) systems, a willingness to learn, and a passion for serving in a multi-campus church environment.

### **Skills & Abilities:**

- A willingness to learn and a strong commitment to the Christian faith, aligned with the church's mission and values.
- Basic knowledge of AVL (Audio, Video, and Lighting) equipment and systems.
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills.
- Strong problem-solving abilities and a desire to troubleshoot technical issues.
- Flexibility and adaptability to work during worship services, rehearsals, and special events.

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

#### **1. Equipment Operation**

- Operate and maintain audio, video, and lighting equipment during worship services, rehearsals, and events.
- Assist in setting up and tearing down equipment as needed.

#### **2. Assist in AVL Setup:**

- Assist in the setup and configuration of AVL equipment for worship services, special events, and outreach programs.
